10. Workshops on Research Methodology will be organized for students of BSW Final & students of III semester.
11. Student support activities shall be promoted in this academic session also.
12. Networking with various organizations for various social causes will be encouraged.
13. Proposal for IQAC funding shall be forwarded to respective authorities.
14. Annual report & AQAR will be prepared.

During the session 2013-14 the college conducted various programmes considering the overall development of the students and giving specific significance to Social Work Education. Activities based on the standards suggested by NAAC on various specific objectives are mentioned in Part B of the report

Part B:

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution:

The major objective of the Institute is to provide Professional Social Work education to the students coming from the neighboring counties, belonging to various section and categories of the society. While imparting social work education up most care is taken to assimilate core values and factors life contribution in national development, enhancing skill and competencies among student, inculcating a desirable value system and heading towards quest for excellence. In the current academic session 2013-14, academic planning committee of the college prepared the academic calendar for the session well in advance. Maximum opportunities were created for student's participation at campus and field level activities. Networking with NGOs and communities through social work practicum was done in order to give platform for applying professional skills and techniques. Women and the weaker sections in the societies were particularly focused up on through Social Work Education.

2. New academic programmes initiated (UG and PG)

No new academic programmes were initiated at undergraduate and postgraduate level.

3. Innovations in curricular design and transaction:

The College faculty actively participated and suggested radical changes in the curriculum content and pattern of examination in Social Work Education of R.T.M. Nagpur University.

4. Inter-disciplinary programmes started:

Professional Social Work Education itself is interdisciplinary programme; however no interdisciplinary programme was started in the current academic session.

5. Examination reforms implemented:

A system to assess academic development of students in the college has been developed as the Internal Examination Committee. Subject wise written examination of each class was conducted at the end of the session. R.T.M. Nagpur University's examination pattern pertaining to structure of question papers, time duration and evaluation was strictly adhered to. Accordingly, the examination was conducted successfully and after evaluation, subject wise marks obtained by students were communicated to respective students enabling them to get to know their respective standings. Improvements in certain areas wherever necessary were also suggested to concerning students.

As PG level has semester patterns semester I and III exams were conducted before Diwali Vacation & semester II and IV exams were held before summer Vacation.

As III semester involves external viva voce practice viva voce was conducted internally for the students.

Objectives of the camp:

1. To expose the students to the social, economic and cultural life of the rural masses and to conduct socio-economic survey on various issues affecting the rural people in view of rural development including the schemes sponsored by the Govt . and voluntary organizations’.

Departure to the camp site:-

The participants and faculty members, after gathering in the college campus at 7.30 am on 6th January to began their journey to the village Karwahi. Total 93 students, five faculty members and one non- teaching staff accompanied students for the camp. Two buses were arranged for the students and after completing arrangements, the bus commenced its journey at 9.15 .am.

Village camp activities-

Following were the programmes held during the village camp.

Inauguration:

The inaugural function was held at 3.45pm. on 6th January .Mrs. Anusaya Warkhade(Sarpanch) chaired the inauguration session. Welcome song was sung by group of students. Mr. N.R Dhurve gave the introductory speech. Dr. H.N. Meshram, NSS officer spoke about objectives, goals, principles and responsibility of NSS volunteers. He explained as to why the camp was being held in Karwahi village for successive years. The intention was to produce tangible result in the life of village community after organising camps in sequence. *Sarpanch* of the village shared the experience during the camp held in the previous years. She shared the view that villagers were happy about it and they expect more this year too. She expressed her warm wishes to everyone and extended all co-operation from the local community. Anchoring was done by Ms. Neha Janbandhu and Pooja Pakkhide.

Prayer / Meditation / exercise :-

All the students, and faculty members wakeup at 5.00 O'clock and assembled for attendance and physical exercise at 5.45 am everyday. .

After the prayer the session started under the instructions of Mr. N.R dhurve with physical exercise followed by Yoga practice which was a new experience for everyone. Binu Mani included *suryanamaskars* and *pranayam* along with other Yoga practices. Along with practice, Mr.N.R. Dhurve explained the benefits of the practices in routine life. Student social worker visited some of the houses and invited people to attend the health checkup camp. Slogans, placards and banners were used in order to communicate the message to the villagers and as a technique to attract the crowd.

Village Survey:

students were divided in ten groups and were assigned to conduct Participatory Rural appraisal (P R A) in different areas. Karwahi, Manegaontek, Dulara and Chhawari were the villagers selected for the purpose. Each group visited different parts of each village to complete their task. They could observe the living conditions of the villagers and they also collected information regarding problems and needs and the areas to be improved.

Health camp:-

A free medical check-up camp was organised at the camp site for the village community. A medical team including Doctors and supporting staff administered general checkup and distributed medicines free of cost. It was an opportunity for most of the villagers to check their health status and get advices and medicines for various ailments.

Help line Parikshechi :-

Mrs.Swati Dharmadikari visited the camp site along with the M.S.W. final year students to give counselling to the students from 10th and 12th stds. preparing for their exams.. Awareness skits were presented giving message to the villagers.

Visit to Panchayat Members:-

Gram Panchayat members and Sarpanch came to visit campers. The students welcomed the members and asked all their doubts to them.

Shramdan:-

All the students set out to collect sacks from the village for the purpose of building a small dam across a small river. It was successfully made out. Afterwards, the students group wise went to village in different areas to clean the village.

Mahila Melawa:-

There was above 30 mahila and all of them were very happy And students gave warm welcome to them .Ms..Shilpa Jibhenkar delivered some awareness talks and some games were carried for women by the students.

Transit walk:-

As part of entertainment and adventure the campers were taken on adventurous walk in the jungle, five kilometres from the camp site. Walking through long stretched farms, students reached the jungle in the afternoon and spent quality time in the midst of dense trees and in the river water.

AnandMela/sports competition:-

The social work students also organised few games so that they could generate some income through the games. Around 3,850/- rupees was collected through the game .There was a good cooperation from the part of the villagers and the amount collected was donated to the primary school, Karwahi where the camp was held for its development.

There was music chair competition was held at the sports ground in Karwahi village. All the school going students participated and it was an amazing event held at the sports ground all enjoyed it.

Report Writing and News:-

All the student social workers gathered in front of the stage to prepare the report of the events held on a particular day .After the dinner it was time for the news committee to present the happenings of the day. The news also included the programmes, and main events of the day.

Evaluation:

Evaluation of each day's activities was made regularly at the end of the day. Each committee in charge commented on the performance of students . Faculty members pointed out the areas needing improvement and suggested ways to improve. It was the time for the students to analyse the activities of the day. It helps different committees to function more effectively avoiding the shortcomings of the previous day.

The general evaluation of the camp was done on the final day of the camp. Camp members got opportunity to express their views, experiences and suggest some ways of effective organisation. It was very obvious that everyone spent time together, shared each other's views, got deeply involved in various activities as a team. All these activities will be an ever living memory and a nostalgic splendour in the days to come.It was good to find that many of the students used the cultural programme to get rid of their shyness, face the crowd and exhibit their talents and skills. It was found that everyone was working with great sense of understanding and cooperation.

Celebrated International Human Rights Day

International Human Rights Day was celebrated on 10th December 2013 at Tirpude College of Social Work. Principal, Dr. K. S. Patil chaired the session, Dr. V. J.
