

IQAC External Peer Team Report

The External Peer Team paid second visit to Tirpude College of Social Work(Autonomous) Nagpur on Monday,4th March 2022 at 12.00 noon to take review and monitor the extent to which the measures for maintenance of standards in the college with autonomous status are adopted and implemented.

The team comprised of following members:-

- 1) Dr.D.V. Naik, Principal, M.K. Umathe Arts & Science and Ramchandra Mokhare Commerce College, Nagpur(Chairman)
- 2) Dr. Chetan Masram , Principal, S.N. Mor. College,Tumsar (Member)
- 3) Dr.Chandu Popatkar, Principal, Kumbhalkar College of Social Work, Wardha (Member)

At the outset, the management, principal and HODs alongwith the faculty welcomed the peer team members to the institution. After holding personal interaction with the principal, teaching staff and administrative office employees, the team members had a review on the functioning of mandatory committees and documents relating to fresh initiatives undertaken, the system adopted vis-à-vis the observations recorded by the External Peer Team during its previous visit on 4th March 2021.

After examining available documents and evidence, the external peer team notes the following observations:-

1. Having adopted autonomy from the session 2019-20, the first batch of students have acquired their MSW degree after passing the four semester course in summer 2021 examination. Similarly, the first batch of students pursuing BSW degree are due to acquire their degrees (six semester course) after passing summer 2022 examination.
2. The IQAC co-ordinator apprised the team members about some fresh measures adopted for maintenance of quality education.
3. The principal informed the members about new diploma/certificate courses floated by the institution. The session 2020-21 saw commencement of four diploma courses and a degree course namely:-
 - i) Advanced P.G. Diploma in Counselling
 - ii) Diploma in event Management
 - iii) Diploma in Mass Communication & Journalism
 - iv) Diploma in Hospitality Studies
 - v) Master of Industrial Relations and Personnel Management (Degree)

Similarly, three additional diploma courses have been started in the session 2021-22 namely:-

- i) One year Diploma in School Counselling
- ii) Certificate Course in Corporate Social Responsibility
- iii) Diploma in Human Resource Management and Labour Law

The Ministry of Information & Broadcasting has allotted the college frequency to run a Community Radio Station named 90.8 F.M. Apna Nagpur which became functional on 16th January 2022.

The committee examined documentations pertaining to the said courses and found the same satisfactory.




4. In view of the prevailing pandemic situation, the examination cell of the college conducted online examination from summer 2019 onwards for all the conducted degree/diploma programmes. The team members visited the examination cell and found the record, documentation and examination process satisfactory.
5. In view of the stipulated UGC guidelines, following documents were examined to confirm the regularity in functioning of the mandatory bodies.
 - i) NAAC Peer Team Review Report and the initiatives taken.
 - ii) Regular submission of Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AQAR) till the session 2020-21.
 - iii) Minutes of meeting of statutory bodies such as Governing Body, Academic Council, Board of Studies, Finance Committee.
 - iv) Audited statements of expenditure of academic year 2020-21.
 - v) Minutes of periodic IQAC meetings.

All the above documents are displayed on the college website.

6. The new initiative taken by the college are found to be in accordance with NAAC Peer Team report with a perspective plan for both short and long term. The IQAC is found to be proactive in introducing the best practice by taking efforts for their implementation.
7. The Board of studies of every department has framed syllabi with topics with relevance. The vision of the college is reflected in the redesigned syllabi.
8. The external Peer Team found that the issue of student-teacher ratio is still remain a cause of concern with sizeable number of vacancies of teaching as well as office staff. The college is suggested to address the issue on priority. In addition to the above observations, the college is equally proactive in promoting co-curricular, cultural, literary activities of the college.
9. It is observed that the college, through the IQAC has studied the new education policy and planning to make efforts in its line.

The External Peer Team, based on its visit and above observations wish to place on record the view that the college is treading in a rightful manner to

achieve its objectives through sincere efforts utilizing all available resources and is maintaining the standards required for an autonomous college.
