








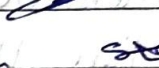
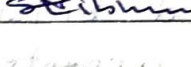


Minutes of the Meeting Held on 13 April 2022

Agenda 1. To confirm minutes of the previous meeting held on 28 September 2021.

The minutes of the last meeting held on 28 Sept. 2021 ~~held on~~ were read for the members and were confirmed.

Agenda 2. Review of academic activities held during the session 2021-22.

Dr. Swati Dharmadhikari presented the academic activities of the session. On review of examination, she informed that all the due examinations were held in online mode due to pandemic restrictions and the results were declared within the timeline. Similarly, village camp

and study tour, which are the mandatory components of the BSW and MSW curricula were organised smoothly. Three blood donation camps were organised successfully by the NSS units of the college. It was further informed that the even semester examinations are also scheduled in due course.

Agenda 3. Restructure/revision of syllabi of BSW and MSW courses.

Syllabi of following degree courses were proposed to be restructured/ revised :-

i] Compulsory English text-books and course contents were changed to be effective from the forthcoming session 2022-23 in phased manner. A detailed proposal was tabled before the members and the same was accepted after some discussion thereon.

ii] Text book of BSW Fifth and Sixth Semester of Marathi (Optional Paper II) was proposed to be replaced with new book 'Bhashavaibhava' Part 3. The same was accepted after examining the course contents tabled in the meeting.

iii] Some parts of course contents in Hindi (Optional paper II) syllabus included in all the six semesters were proposed to undergo partial changes pertaining to internal assessment, non-textual contents and rapid reading. The proposal was accepted. All these three proposals were accepted to be tabled before the Academic Council for its approval.

Agenda 4. To consider and approve syllabus of newly proposed diploma course.

Dr. D.R. Masram presented before the members proposal for new diploma course titled 'Diploma in Social Entrepreneurship in Water Technology'. The members, after examining its duration, unitwise contents and academic value, the members decided to clear the said diploma course for the approval of Academic Council. This diploma course would be run in joint collaboration with ~~Sarvid International Pvt Ltd,~~ ~~Atapur~~ Natraj Niketan Sanstha, Nagpur.
