The concept of (D)velopment, despite all its criticism, continues to occupy a central place in policy framework advocated by most of the developing countries in the world. Development needs to be viewed as larger conception inclusive of all the aspects that constitute well-being of the individuals in the society. The essential understanding that underpins the process of Development is that it is a steady linear course of action participated by different actors and coordinated to accomplish the required outcome. It hardly interrogates the role of actors involved, their social position and the larger power inequalities influencing and shaping the process of development. Development demands a new bottom-up approach that clearly lays down the view and perspective of those living at the stack bottom of the society. It is with this view that the conference is organised to understand the development related issues of the weaker sections in India which include the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Women, Children and Minorities to whom the benefits of the development discourse

have only touched tangently despite all these years of robust planning for them. The conference is contextualised within the 17 sustainable goals enlisted by the United Nations as the parameters and targets of development discourse. The conference proposes to locate the weaker sections in India comprising the above descriptions on all the 17 sustainable goal parameters. The themes, therefore, for the investigation are the same as the UN sustainable goals 2030 with the particular understanding of the weaker sections in India. Nation specific experiences from the participants from the foreign countries will add to the understanding of the Indian question. In a similar, vein it can also enrich the policy debate outside.

9. Resilient infrastructure, inclusive and sustainable industrialization and innovation

11. Inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable cities and human settlements
12. Sustainable consumption and production patterns
13. Climate change and its impacts
14. Conservation and sustainable use of oceans, seas and marine resources
15. Protection, restoration and promoting sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems.
16. Sustainably managed forests, combat desertification, and halt and reverse land degradation and halt biodiversity loss
17. Promoting peaceful and inclusive societies, access to justice and building effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels
18. Strengthening the means of implementation and revitalizing the global partnership.
