PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

Introduction: The Master of Social Work (MSW) programme shall be of two years duration. The programme shall be spread over four semesters. The degree of Master of Social Work is a professional degree in social work. The MSW programme is aimed to equip students to work as a change agent at grass root level and also contribute up to policy level. It is a recognized qualification for professional positions, in Governmental, Industrial and Voluntary sector organizations. This degree equips a student with knowledge, skills and attitude required for the field of social work.

Eligibility: A Student having Bachelors degree in Social work or in any discipline.

Medium of Instruction: Medium of instruction shall be English, Marathi or Hindi

Course Structure: The following shall be the theory classes, field work practicum and Research Project in the semester pattern for the Master of Social Work to be introduced from the academic session 2019-2020.

Note—i) There shall be 7 days village camp in 2nd semester ,Educational tour of 5 days in 4th semester.

ii) Summer placement of 15 days after 2nd semester and block placement of one month after 4th semester shall be mandatory requirement for successful completion of the degree.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Marks structure for theory papers: 80 Marks for Theory Examination and 20 Marks for Internal Assessment.
- 2. Internal assessment will be based on assignments from each paper/subjects. Student must appear for the internal assessment in the paper/subject, failing in this shall lead to forfeiting the marks for the same.
- **3.** Units: There are Four units in each theory paper. Thus the students will have to answer four questions with two internal options and fifth question will be compulsory.
- 4. Attendance in each component of Social Work Practicum is mandatory. Students remaining absent in any of the component shall lead to forfeiting the marks for the same except Viva voce.

- 5. Appearing in Viva voce examination shall be mandatory, in case of failure in attending viva voce the candidate shall be declared as fail in SWP.
- 6. Summer placement of 15 days after 2^{nd} semester, Block placement of one month after 4^{th} semester exams shall be mandatory, preferably in Social sector, under the guidance of the college supervisor. The agencies will be chosen by the students. The correspondence will be through the respective SWP in-charges of 2^{nd} and 4^{th} semester, in case of non completion, the result and degree will be withheld till successful completion of the same.
- **7.** The students will have to pass independently in theory and practical exams. The criteria for passing will be 40% marks in respective subject and aggregate 50%. For promotion to next semester passing in Social Work Practicum is mandatory.
- **8 .Examination**:- Examination of all subjects of Programmes shall be conducted by the Tirpude college of social work as per the scheme of Examination prescribed by the Board of Studies. Every student desirous for appearing at MSW examination will have to complete practicum work as per the directions of the concerned teachers and obtain completion certificate to that effect duly signed by SWP in-charge . For the IVth semester, the students shall also obtain signature of Principal on the certificate of completion of SWP and Research project. The student who fails to produce completion certificate will not be eligible to appear for the related practical examination.
 - a. The term end examination, shall be conducted by the college TCSW, Nagpur as per the declared time table.
 - b. As per the declared time table there will be re-examination of theory papers for the students who have failed in main examination
 - c. ATKT rules shall be applicable only after the results of re-examination have been declared.
 - d. Repeat viva of the candidates who have failed in SWP shall be held after successful completion of the SWP under the guidance of supervisor in the given time.
 - e. Research project failure???????
- f. The degree shall be awarded by R.T.M.Nagpur university , which will have name of the college mentioned on it .
- g. Academic calendar showing dates of commencement and end of teaching, internal assessment tests & term end examination, repeat examinations/viva shall be duly notified before commencement of each semester every year by the College.

COURSE DETAILS

1. Core Subjects (MSW I)

- 1.1 During the first year of the two-year Master of Social Work course, it shall be mandatory for all students to study ten theory papers (Core Subjects). Each core subject theory paper shall be of 4 Credits. Five core subject theory papers shall be taught during the 1st Semester and the remaining five papers shall be taught during the 2nd Semester.
- 1.2 In theory of core subjects, 5.50 grade points, which is equivalent to 'E' grade, shall be required for passing in each Semester. Similarly, in Social Work Practicum, 5 grade points, which is equivalent to 'E' grade, shall be required for passing. A minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 5 in each Semester shall be required for passing each Semester.

2. Specialization Groups (MSW II)

- 2.1 There shall be four specialization groups. Each specialization group shall have six specialization-specific theory papers. Each specialization-specific theory paper shall be of 04 Credits. Three specialization-specific theory papers shall be in the 3rd Semester while the remaining three shall be in the 4th Semester. Students should opt for any one specialization group of their choice during the second year (3rd Semester) of the two-year Master of Social Work course. There shall be no option for changing the specialization group which is opted during the 3rd Semester . Students are required to continue with the same specialization group during the 4th Semester.
- 2.2 In theory paper of each specialization subject, 5 grade points, which is equivalent to 'E' grade, shall be required for passing in each Semester. Similarly, in Social Work Practicum, 5 grade points, which is equivalent to 'E' grade, shall be required for passing. A minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 5 for each Semester shall be required for passing each Semester.
