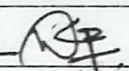
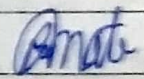
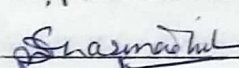
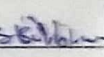
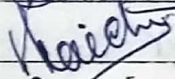
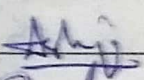
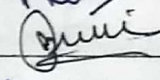
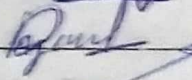
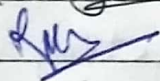
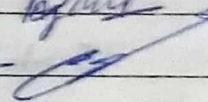


Minutes of Emergent Meeting Held on 21 Dec 2019

Sub. 1: The member secretary read the minutes of the previous meeting held on 24 June 2019 for the present members and were declared approved.

Sub. 2 : Review of fee structure for courses under autonomy -

Sub. 2 : The proposed fee structure for the courses to be started under autonomy was presented by the representatives of departments. The structure was approved by the members to seek further approval from the Governing Body.

Proposed fee structure is as follows :

- i) Master in Industrial Relations and Personnel Management (Two years)
Rs 40,000 + 8000 examination fees per semester. (Rs. 2000/- per semester)
- ii) Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) Three years - Rs. 46840 for CBSE students, Rs. 46840 for State Board stud. per year
- iii) Bachelor of Science in Hospitality Studies (Three years) - Rs. 2,31,180/-
(74020 + 74220 + 74520 each year)
- iv) Advanced P.G. Diploma in Counseling
Rs. 15,060
- v) Diploma in Digital Photography Rs. 20,000
- vi) Certificate Course in Cinematography - 10,000
- vii) Diploma in Hospitality Studies - Rs. 48,220
- viii) Diploma in Event Management - Rs. 15,000
- ix) Diploma in Mass Communication & Journalism - Rs. 15,000/-

Sub. 3: Review of previous academic session 2019-20-

Sub. 3: Observations and opinions on the recently concluded first academic session of BSW and MSW first year under autonomy (2019-20) were invited by Hon'ble Principal. Members expressed satisfaction over successful completion of the same. However, the examination committee recorded its observations on re-examination facility provided to failure students. It was experienced that it is too tedious a procedure to conduct re-examination of failure students as it involves repeat of entire exam exercise in a very short time span. Moreover, some students tend to misuse the facility by not being serious during the first attempt, as they are getting another chance to appear for a paper in no time. Hence, the committee offered to do away with re-examination facility from the ensuing session 2020-2021. After elaborate discussion on the matter, it was unanimously decided to abolish the re-examination facility for failure students. As a result, failure students will have to appear in failed subject at the next semester examination in line with RTM Nagpur University pattern.

Hon'ble Principal apprised the members that no new courses were started in the previous session as RTM Nagpur University denied permission. ~~The~~ This denial was challenged in Hon'ble High Court which has recently ruled the matter in college's favour. The new proposed courses shall be started in the coming academic session.

Sub. 4. Approval to restructuring of syllabi of Bsw and Msw programme with amendment in directions -

Incharge of Academic Planning Committee Dr. Shilpa Puranik apprised the members that in view of curtailed current academic session due to COVID-19 pandemic followed by guidelines from the UGC in the month of August syllabi for Bsw part I and Part II and also that of Msw Part I and Part II courses were reduced by 25% of original ~~size~~ contents for the academic session 2020-21 only. The same was accepted.

As regards amendments in directions regarding examination, following amendments in directions were discussed upon and decided to be incorporated in the original Directions for display on college website -

1. Abolishment of re-examination facility.
2. Under Value Addition Activities (VAA) for Msw programme, total CGPA will be 7.946 instead of 7.93 that was in earlier existence. Similarly, total credits shall be 110 instead of earlier 108. 2 credits = 50 marks
3. Table showing incentive marks for Field Action Projects (FAP) be amended as:

Dharmadhikari in the faculties of Management and Science and Technology for B.B.A. and B.Sc. in Hospitality Management as per the UGC directions for autonomous colleges.
- ii) It was decided that departments other than Social Work shall depute one personnel as exam incharge to coordinate with the CoE. These departments shall also submit

their yearly academic calendars with the CoE at the beginning of each session.

iii) For repeat viva-voce examination of Social Work students, it was decided to charge additional fees from the students.

In conclusion, the member secretary expressed vote of thanks to the present members and the chairman to declare the meeting as concluded.
