Sub 3.1 - Minutes of the previous meeting held on 13 February 2022 were read by the Principal and were confirmed.

Sub. 3.2 - Principal Dr. Swati Dharmadhikari apprised the members that the degree programme Master of Industrial Relations and Personnel Management^{3rd sem.} Diploma in School Counselling and a Certificate Course in Corporate Social Responsibility were started in the college from the ongoing academic session 2021-22.

Sub 3.3 - Principal stated that as far as staff vacancies (regular) are concerned, total 04 posts of teachers, 04 non-teaching posts and that of a Principal are vacant and steps are being taken to fill-in the above vacancies. She added that proposal to fill posts on compassionate ground due to deceased staff of the college namely Late Dilip Gosavi and Late Manish Deshmukh was sent to the office of Assistant Commissioner, Social Welfare, of which one was accepted and wife of Late Dilip Gosavi has joined as a peon.

Sub 3.4 - Dr. S.K. Dharmadhikari informed that the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has allotted a community radio station to the college and its broadcast commenced from 16th January. It was also informed that a committee was formed to look after its functioning with Dr. Swati Dharmadhikari as the Director.

Sub 3.5 - IQAC co-ordinator Dr. Shipra Puranik informed the members that annual report for the previous academic session was prepared in time and the Internal Quality Assurance Report (IQAR) had been sent to NAAC, Bangalore.

Sub 3.6 - The Principal informed that Shri Chandrashekhar Nikose, Library Assistant in the college who was on deputation in the office of the Divisional Collector has returned in college service after three years after prologing correspondence with the concerned office.

Sub 3.7 - Under any other matter, some members suggested that behavioral ethics and code of conduct be explained to the students during their first orientation programme. The suggestion was welcomed by all the present members.

At the outset, Mr. Manish Deshmukh, college faculty and Mr. Dilip Gosavi, college peon, who lost their lives during COVID pandemic were paid tributes by the present members.
